The dam is located in center of the city of Helsinki, capital of Finland. It's located only 7 km from the parliament house.

The dam was built in 1876 to supply water to the city of Helsinki

Water department does not use it anymore, but the site has cultural historical values.

Originally the river had two free-flowing rapids in the area. The dam is in the main branch of the river. fiere fka

The dam is partially blocking access to river Vantaa, which is a 101 kilometers long river.

For example critically endangered whitefish (Coregonus lavaretus L.) is not able to migrate at all.

Also critically endangered trouts jump against the dam

Construction of the dam fools trouts (Salmon trutta) to jump.

Decision about the fate of the dam is due before the end of the year 2016 from the city council.

Objections for removing the dam are mainly based on resistance to change and a sense of place.
