National framework

Law on Water and Aquatic Environments of 30 December 2006 (text of the law)

Transversal structure are public or privately owned

- -Built before 20th century : no time limit to water rights;
- Built after : time limited water rights (up to 75 years);
- Built with no water abstraction purpose (> 50 cm) : no time limit;
- I f no renewal of water rights: removal required

National framework

WFD implementation : Law on Water and Aquatic Environments of 30 December 2006 (text of the law)

River classification in France, adapted to the WFD:

Regarding transversal structures, rivers are now classified in:

- LISTE 1: rivers to preserve the river continuity NO NEW OBSTACLES ALLOWED: it includes high ecological status rivers, migratory fish rivers and rivers acting as biological reservoirs: 30 % of river stretches;
- LISTE 2 : rivers to restore the river continuity: where sediment transport and fish migration have to be ensured: 11% of rivers stretches, 24% of transversal structures




Main public bodies involved at local level

Organisation for WFD implemention: A decentralized management, by watersheds




14 watersheds/river basins

12 basin committees responsible for :

- Assessing the state of the watershed
- Establishing the 6-years management plan, RBMPs (SDAGE) and Programme measures

at local level

"SAGE": local management plans



Status of SBMPs in France

 Territorial contracts or and local or regional environmental contracts (river, lake, aquifer, bay...)

Progress of existing contracts in France is available on the Gest'eau website.

• Through these, river restoration project are implemented by local goverment, river syndicats

Funding for river aquatic environment

- Public funding for a project: up to 80 %
- from the Water agency, regional, departmental, local authorities, Europe, ...
- Amendement been voted 7 april 2021 to prevent of removal of weirs !!!!
